

TEN STEPS

TO STARTING A TEAM

- 1. Look for a volunteer person to take the lead...a Head Coach (min. 21 years old) and some boys and girls, 5 for a trap squad and 3 for skeet and sporting clays (12th grade and under) that want to learn how to shoot or become better shooters by participating in a Team based shooting program.
- 2. Find a place to practice, a home gun club or shooting facility.
- 3. The Head Coach is required to have a Shotgun Coach Certification credential and Register* with the CYSSA. (*Head Coach Registration Form*) Certification classes are available through the CYSSA. See website "Other Events" calendar.
- **4.** The Head Coach and kids decide on a name for their Team and who will be the contact person, then Register* the Team (*Team Registration Form*) with the CYSSA.
- 5. The Head Coach may want some help, so find some friends, parents or others who want to be Assistant Coaches or Adult Volunteers and Register* them with the CYSSA. (Assistant Coach and Adult Volunteer Registration Form) Note: Assistant Coaches are required to take a Shotgun Coach Certification class also.
- **6.** When you have your kids and parents together Register* your athletes with the CYSSA. Parents/guardians and athletes will be required to fill out and sign contracts. (*Consent and Waiver, Sportsmanship forms*)
- 7. Send in the Head Coach and Team Registration forms in ASAP then you can register your other volunteers & athletes later... but before the first competition.
- 8. Start practices! Make sure your team members are making good academic progress and have a minimum 2.0GPA.
- Sign up for Series Shoots by using the Green Pre-Squad button on the website...there are 100 target Series Shoots put on at various gun clubs March-June.
- 10. See how your Team has improved during the season by bringing them all to the State Championships in June...lots of vendors, food and fun, plus great competition!
